Upload page 2 of the MSHSAA Physical Exam Form after completion of the physical. Go to [your high school's web page](#) to access PRIVIT, complete your information, and upload the form. NOTE: If you enter your information on the wrong high school website you will have to do it again. PRIVIT cannot transfer the information.
