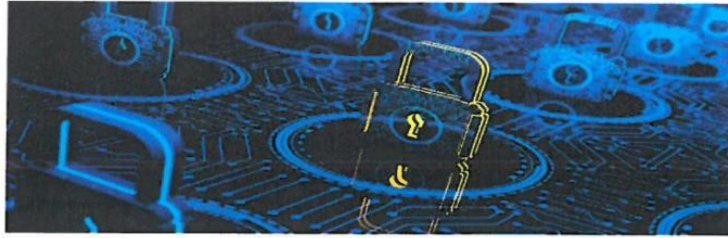

- **NEW INFO REGARDING SPORTS PHYSICALS:** MSHSAA has passed a ballot allowing physicals to be used for a period of 2 full years from the date of the exam. This change is effective immediately. This new policy is good for all physicals dated February 1, 2018 and later. As an example, if a physical was completed on February 10, 2018, then that physical would be honored until February 9, 2020. On February 10, 2020, the student would need to provide a new physical examination.

SLMS will continue to collect physicals using the official MSHSAA form found on our website at http://slms.lsr7.org/wp-content/uploads/sites/36/2014/07/PreParticipationPhysicalEvaluation_0407.pdf.

- **Incoming 9th graders to Lee's Summit West:** LSW has an online program called Privit for submitting MSHSAA sports physicals. You will need to create a profile and complete the online registration in Privit. You can find the instructions to use the system on the LSW webpage at <http://lswhs.lsr7.org/studentlife/resources/>. The Privit link used to create your profile is also found on the LSW webpage. You will not have to submit a paper copy to the activities/athletic office at LSW, however you will need to upload the physical into Privit!
