<p>Schedule</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 days of in-person learning at school • 3 days of virtual at-home learning on your own • Wednesday = continuation of work with opportunities for “live” virtual help sessions • Students with last names A-K will come to school on Monday-Tuesday • Students with last names L-Z will come to school on Thursday-Friday • Mondays and Thursdays = A days • Tuesdays and Fridays = B days
<p>Assignments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read all directions and examples • Pay attention to due dates and complete assignments on time • Communicate with your teacher if you turn in a late assignment per your team or teacher’s directions • Independent work may be assigned during at-home learning
<p>“Live” Virtual Help Sessions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Will be held through Google Meet • Help sessions will have their own code; do not share code with others • Teachers’ help session codes follow the same format <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ LastnameHelp ○ i.e. HansenHelp, LewisHelp, GroomHelp, FreebornHelp • Enter help sessions with yourself muted • Keep yourself muted while others are talking • Use the chat features appropriately
<p>Communication</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In-person • Schoology Messaging • Email: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ check your email frequently ○ teachers are not able to return emails immediately; do not expect responses outside of “school hours” ○ recheck all written directions prior to emailing questions ○ be detailed and as clear as possible in your email request
<p>Organization</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep track of assignments using your school planbook • Reference Schoology calendar and/or team calendars for due dates • Organize your Google Drive files – utilize folders
